The cooperation for environmental protection between the Italian Ministry for the Environment Land and Sea and the Romanian Ministries has started with the Memorandum of Understanding signed in 2006.



According to the agreement, both States are committed in the development of different activities of technical assistance, training and dissemination of experiences in a variety of sectors: public relations, industrial pollution, environmental legislation, access and use of European funds, waste chemicals management. The necessary technical assistance to develop an information system between the national, regional and local environmental structures has been also provided.

A second Memorandum of Understanding on climate change and on the development of projects eligible under the provisions of the Kyoto Protocol has been signed in 2007. This Memorandum intends to support the activities of Italian companies interested in working in the environmental sector in Romania. Moreover, this programme aims to provide technical assistance to the public officials of the Romanian Ministry and to develop a study on the use of sugar beets for the production of bio-fuels.
